

# Unit 6 – Around the house

In this unit, you are going to learn to give information about rooms in a house, as well as ask for and give information about where things are. You will also learn to tell someone to do something.

## A. THE HOUSE

**i** In France, houses are made of bricks or stone but seldom made of wood. They are very solid and can stand for more than a hundred years.
